

Academic requirements for entering IB DP (internal students in pre-IB classes)

According to Admissions Policy, students must achieve at least a “2” grade in a particular subject to pursue the subject in the related DP subject group at a higher level. If students are unable to apply for 3 courses at a higher level, they cannot fulfil the general requirements of IB DP and cannot get the full Diploma. As a result, they will be encouraged to move to a parallel non-IB DP class or receive a non-examination student status¹.

This document brings essential information about the list of subjects in the 2nd pre-IB class and the linkage to particular IB DP subjects.

Requirements for entering IB DP subjects at a higher level (HL)

If the students want to enter the subject **Czech A literature** (HL), they need to achieve at least a “2” grade in the following subjects in the 2nd semester of the 2nd pre-IB class:

Česká literatura

Světová literatura

If the students want to enter the subject **English B** (HL), they need to achieve at least a “2” grade in the following subject in the 2nd semester of the 2nd pre-IB class:

Anglický jazyk

If the students want to enter the subject **Geography** (HL), they need to achieve at least a “2” grade in the following subjects in the 2nd semester of the 2nd pre-IB class:

Regiony v souvislostech

Geografie a geologie

If the students want to enter the subject **History** (HL), they need to achieve at least a “2” grade in the following subjects in the 2nd semester of the 2nd pre-IB class:

Světové dějiny

České dějiny

If the students want to enter the subject **Biology** (HL), they need to achieve at least a “2” grade in the following subjects in the 2nd semester of the 2nd pre-IB class:

Biologie organismů

Organismy a prostředí

Biochemie

If the students want to enter the subject **Chemistry** (HL), they need to achieve at least a “2” grade in the following subjects in the 2nd semester of the 2nd pre-IB class:

Chemie sloučenin

Biochemie
